WAC 308-100-033 Minimum training requirements.

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 46.46.01.110, 46.25.060 and 46.25.140

This amendment allows combined lab, range & observation hours as a substitute for additional behind the wheel hours and adds "Military" training certificates as approved proof of training. This training is required in order to qualify for a Commercial Drivers License.
