Purpose: The existing statute governing disclosure of the names of vehicle owners requires that when the owner's name or address is requested by an Attorney or by a Private Investigator the owner must be notified of the request and provided with the name and address of the requester. Effective January 1, 2014, owners will continue receiving notice of the request, but will no longer receive the name and address of the requester. This rule amendment aligns the WAC with the revised statute. DOL is also recodifying the rule from Ch. 308-56A to Ch. 308-10 to better align Agency WAC sections with our organizational structure.
