Why am I receiving this notification?

Washington State law, RCW 46.12.635(4)(a), requires that DOL notify you when it has granted a request for your vehicle or vessel registration information to an attorney or a licensed private investigator.

What information was provided?

- Registered owner(s) name and mailing address. If you have both a physical address and a mailing address on file, only the mailing address was provided.
- Basic information about the vehicle or vessel, such as plate or WN#, make, model, and year.

What do I need to do?

You're not required to do anything in response to this letter. To learn the specific occupation of the requesting party, submit a written request to DOL NOTIFICATIONS, MS 48209, POB 2957, OLYMPIA, WA., 98507, or email notifications@dol.wa.gov within five (5) days from receipt of this letter. Include the vehicle license plate number and the date of disclosure.

How can I get more information?

No additional information can be provided to you over the telephone. RCW 46.12.635(4)(c) prohibits DOL from disclosing the name and address of the requesting party unless you have a valid court order that restricts another person from contacting you or a member of your household. The court order must have been in effect on the date information was provided. If you have such an order, please submit a copy of it and this notification letter to the e-mail or mail address shown above.
