GENERAL RECORD KEEPING REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 308-72-895, 308-77-240 and 308-78-070, each claimant must keep records reflecting:

- All fuel receipts showing the number of gallons received and taxes paid.
- Gallons of fuel used in each piece of equipment (for refundable and nonrefundable usage).
- Other uses, gains, and losses of fuel.
- Physical inventory of fuel.
- On-highway and off-highway mileage records for each licensed vehicle.

These records must be kept for each refund claim filed with the department. All refund claims and associated records are subject to audit and must be kept for five (5) years from the date of refund claim.
