Release 1 IFTA, IRP

- The number of customers accessing, registering, and using the Taxpayer Access Point (TAP) continues to grow.
- Customer problems with TAP continue to be resolved and Service Agents can now access client accounts with ease.

Release 2 Fuel Tax, Refund, Audit, Finance and Collection

- Preparation for implementation of Release 2 of the PRFT Modernization System continues with Prorate and Fuel Tax staff.

NEW! Fuel Tax Consolidation Law web link

A new webpage explaining the Fuel Tax Consolidation requirements can be found [here](#). The new law impacts Fuel Tax customers by consolidating license types, standardizing language, and merging Revised Code of Washington (RCWs) for motor fuel and special fuel. Licensing forms and bond requirements will be revised. It establishes a new category of licensing – “Terminal Operators”. More information will be communicated as it becomes available.
