Notice of Permanent Rules for
Application for driver's license or identicard

Adoption of: WAC 308-104-014 Application for driver's license or identicard

Effective date: These rule changes will become effective 31 days after filing or on approximately December 23, 2017.

What are the agency's reasons for adopting this rule?

SB 5382 (C 122 L 17) enacted during the 2017 legislative session, authorizes the department to create rules that allow the department to issue identicards at a reduced cost to applicants who are under the age of eighteen and without a permanent residence address.

Summary of all public comments received on this rule proposal and the agency's response to those comments:

The agency did not receive any public comments.

Changes made to the proposed WAC as a result of public comment:

There are no differences between the text of the proposed rule as published in the register and the text of the rule as adopted.
