



# PREPROPOSAL STATEMENT OF INQUIRY

**CR-101 (June 2004)**  
(Implements RCW 34.05.310)  
Do NOT use for expedited rule making

**Agency:** Department of Licensing

**Subject of possible rule making:** To allow insurance carriers, employers, or their agents to enter into contracts with the Department of Licensing to participate in the Abstract Driving Records (ADR) monitoring service

**Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject:** RCW 46.01.110

**Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:**

Need to establish guidelines for contracting with insurance companies, employers, or agents to participate in the ADR monitoring service. This will include: the requirements to contract with DOL, recording keeping and reporting, and audit requirements.
