**Washington Administrative Code  
Notice of Permanent Rules for  
Destroyed or wrecked vehicle-Reporting-Rebuilt**

**Adoption of:** WAC 308-56A-460 Destroyed or wrecked vehicle-Reporting-Rebuilt

**Effective date:** These rule changes will become effective 31 days after filing or on July 7, 2019.

**What are the agency's reasons for adopting this rule?**

RCW 46.12.600(4) requires Market Value Threshold (MVT) be increased when the target of \$50.00 has been reached. There are no foreseen effects. Market value threshold has reached a fifty dollar increase requiring an update to WAC 308-56A-460(3). The new market value threshold amount on July 1st 2019 is seven thousand nine hundred thirty dollars..

**Summary of all public comments received on this rule proposal and the agency's response to those comments:**

No comments were received.

**Changes made to the proposed WAC as a result of public comment:**

There are no differences between the text of the proposed rules as published in the register and the text of the rule as adopted.
