Purpose: These updates are being adopted for Washington state to remain in compliance with state (RCW 18.310) and federal rules under section 1124 to Title XI of the Financial Institutions Reform, Recovery and Enforcement Act (FIRREA) as modified by section 1473 of the Dodd-Frank Act.
These changes update the existing licensure period to 1 year to accommodate for 2019 legislative changes; modify existing rules to allow for the collection and transmission of Appraisal Management Company National Registry data and fees to the Appraisal Subcommittee as required by Title XI, and adopt a new rule pertaining to standards of practice as required by the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice of the Appraisal Foundation.
