

## Driver Training Schools Announcement

### Students with Non-Photo Instruction Permit and no photo identification

We've gotten an increased number of customers wanting to get their driver license but don't have the necessary documents. Students without photo identification **must** bring a birth certificate **plus** a parent or guardian with photo identification.

### Students 25 years old and under

If you're unable to meet the general ID requirements, you may show us all the following instead:

- Your parent/guardian must come with you. They must attest to your identity.
  - Before attestation, your parent/guardian must show:
    - Proof of their identity by providing one item from the Stand-Alone document list.
    - Proof that they're your parent/guardian. This could be:
      - A certified birth certificate.
      - Adoption papers.
      - Or a school transcript with their name on it.
    - If the your last name is different than your parent/guardians, we'll need more documents such as a marriage certificate or divorce decree.
- One item from the A-List,  
**or**
- One item from the B-List. It must establish your name and date of birth. This could be a certified birth certificate or adoption papers.
