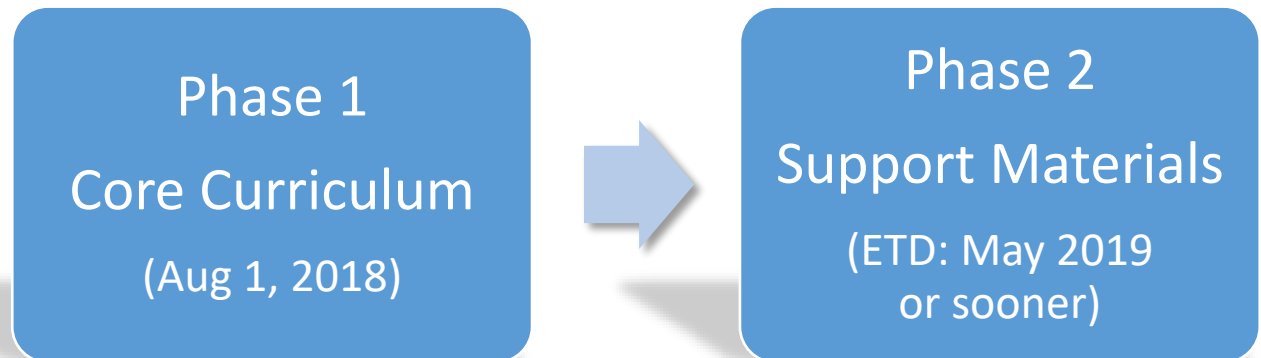


## HB 1481: Two-Phase Approach



With regard to HB 1481, we plan to move forward in two phases.

The first phase is the development of our Core Curriculum. Our goal in Phase 1 is to identify the knowledge, skills, and behaviors that all students should have by the time they graduate from a driver training school in our State, no matter which program they attend. The **Core Curriculum** will be developed and disseminated no later than **August 1, 2018**.

The second phase of the plan is to then develop or adopt corresponding **Supportive Materials** to assist schools and teachers to teach the concepts identified in our Core Curriculum. The supportive materials (lesson plans, quizzes, videos, etc.) will be offered as a comprehensive, useful option for schools who may choose to utilize them.

It is important to remember that our Core Curriculum is just the first step in an on-going process. The DOL will spend the first year after the Core Curriculum is released helping schools get ready to implement it. Our goal is to serve you in any way we can to best meet the outcomes identified in our Core Curriculum. Concurrent with schools that might choose to develop their own new materials, we will be developing the State's Supportive Materials following the release of the Core Curriculum and will make them available for use as soon as possible.
