

## Snow Bike Highway Use Declaration

Use this form to certify and register a snow bike for highway and public roadway use. When used on public roadways, the bike must conform to all applicable federal and state motor vehicle safety standards. The operator of the motorcycle must also have a valid Washington driver license and motorcycle endorsement. For additional information, visit [dol.wa.gov](http://dol.wa.gov).

To register your snow bike for highway and public roadway use, you must complete this declaration when you initially register your snow bike. This allows the registered owner to maintain licenses at the same time for both motorcycle and snow bike use. Take this form, a completed [Vehicle Title Application, form 420-001](#), and ownership documents to any vehicle licensing office. Applicable fees are due at time of registration.
