- · Bills of sale or invoices for all major component parts
- Receipts for all parts used in the construction
- Certificate of vehicle inspection completed by the Washington State Patrol
- · Certified scale weight slip
- Declaration of Value form TD-420-737
- Odometer disclosure statement if the model year is less than 10 years old
- Frame certification (if applicable)
- Bumper certfication (if applicable)
