



Intermittent Use Trailer License Plate Application

Apply for an intermittent use trailer license plate for a trailer with a scale weight of 2,000 pounds or less in good working order. These plates are for personal use only. You may use them for participation in club activities, exhibitions, tours, parades, and occasional pleasure use. They can not be used for commercial or business purposes.
