Washington Administrative Code Notice of Permanent Rules for Application for Driver's License – Removing the Collection of Mother's Maiden Name

- Adoption of: Amend: WAC 308-104-014 Application for driver's license or Identicard.
- **Effective date:** These rule changes will become effective 31 days after filing or on January 28, 2021.

What are the agency's reasons for adopting this rule?

The Department is filing to adopt an amendment to WAC 308-104-014 which will update the Department's policy and procedure for processing applications for driver licenses, identification cards and instruction permits. The amendment will end the Department's collection of an applicant's maiden name. There is no longer a need to collect this information and it is not needed to establish a person's identity. See also Governor's Exec. Order, 17-01.
