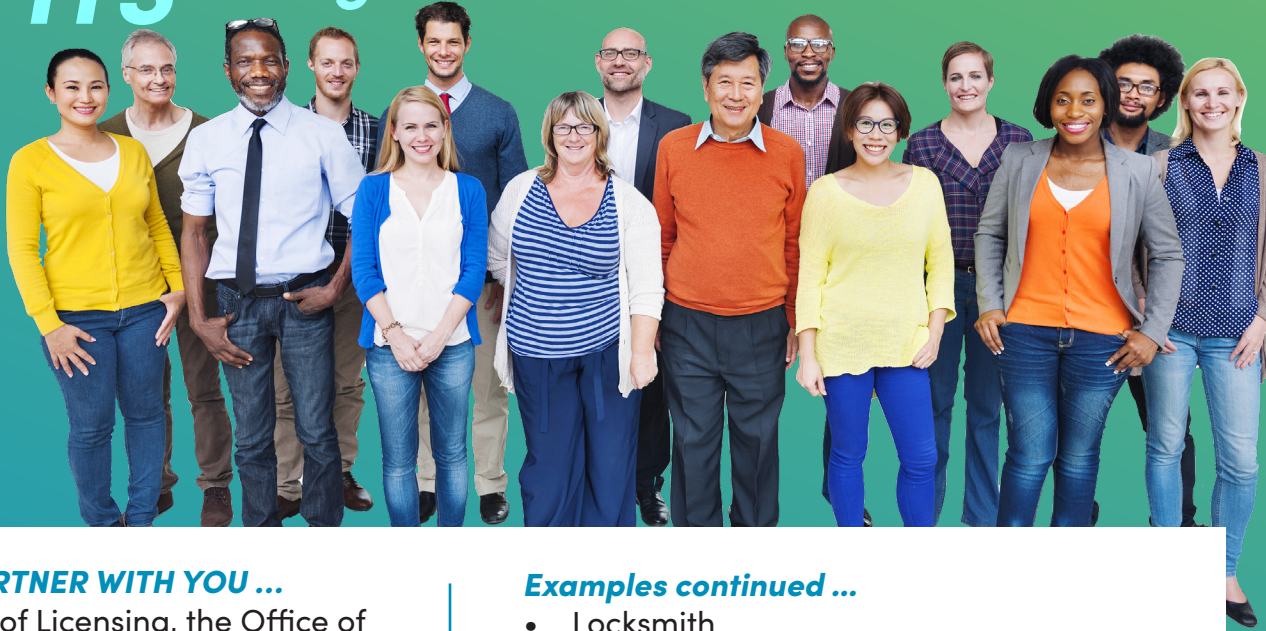

1 Licensed business owners can find out if they are eligible for either the state or federal program (or both) through the Office of Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprise (OMWBE) at: www.omwbe.wa.gov

2 If you are eligible, apply for certification through OMWBE at: www.omwbe.wa.gov/certification/
