

Tribal License Plate Application

Tribal governments and enrolled tribal members can use this form to apply for a tribal plate.

Step 1-Confirm Eligibility

Only tribal governments and enrolled tribal members are eligible to receive tribal license plates. Tribal members must provide proof of eligibility when applying to the Department for a tribal license plate. A tribal ID shall be sufficient evidence to prove eligibility.



Step 3–Personalized plate (complete **ONLY** if requesting a personalized tribal license plate)

- Check to see if your plate is available at <u>dol.wa.gov</u>.
- Certain letter and number combinations are not allowed.
- Unacceptable plates include those which may be: sexual or vulgar in nature; misleading; related to
 intoxicating substances or illegal activities; implying racial, ethnic, lifestyle, or gender slurs; or are contrary to
 our mission to promote highway safety.
- Complaints may result in the cancellation of a personalized plate.
- We will make the plate exactly as indicated on the application.
- Allow at least 8 weeks to receive your plates.
- · List plate choice in order of preference.
- · Characters:
 - You can use letters, numbers, dashes, or spaces. You cannot use unusual characters: #, %, &, @, etc. Spaces and dashes are considered characters; leave a box empty to indicate a space.
 - Clearly show the letter or number characters "I," "1," "O," or "0" (zero). Because of similarities with "I" or "1" and "O" or "0" (zero), we treat them as the same. If one version already exists, you won't be able to use the other. For example, ROOT = R00T and SING = S1NG.
 - Enter the meaning of the plate.

Step 3-Personalized plate (continued)

Standard-size plates have 1-7 characters; motorcycle and small trailer plates have 1-6 characters.



If none of the above personalized plate choices are processed, please issue a full refund.

NOTE: Your personalized plate will be cancelled and available for another vehicle owner to use, if:

- You do not renew your personalized plate within 45 days after the renewal date.
- You do not transfer your personalized plate to a new vehicle within 30 days of the sale of your previous vehicle.

Step 4-Required fees and form submittal

You can either mail or take this form to a vehicle licensing office depending on if you are requesting a personalized tribal license plate:

- Tribal background license plates without personalization
 - Take this form to any vehicle licensing office and pay the required fees; OR
 - Mail this form to **any vehicle licensing office** with the required fees in a check or money order, payable to Department of Licensing—contact any vehicle licensing office for the correct plate fee.
- **Personalized tribal license plates**—for personalized plate fees, see <u>dol.wa.gov</u> (**NOTE**: If requesting a personalized tribal plate, include both background and personalized plate fees.)
 - Take this form to the King County Records and Licensing Services and pay the required fees; OR
 - Mail this form and required fees in a check or money order, payable to Department of Licensing, to:
 Special Plate Unit, Department of Licensing, PO Box 9909, Olympia, WA 98507-8500

Applications mailed to DOL without the required fees will be returned.
