

November update:

Release 1 IFTA, IRP

- Fourth quarter tax returns for IFTA licensees were mailed to customers. This is the first mailing of this type by the new DOL PRFT Fuel Tax system.
- The number of customers accessing, registering, and using the Taxpayer Access Point (TAP) continues to grow.
- TAP can now be accessed from the [DOL front page](#) and from the [Online Services](#) selection.

Release 2 Fuel Tax, Refunds, Audit, Finance and Collection

- Preparation for implementation of Release 2 of the PRFT Modernization System continues with Prorate and Fuel Tax staff.
- Dedicated staff have been added to the project to increase accuracy and efficiency.

Fuel Tax Consolidation Law (SHB 1883) Effective July 1, 2016

This new law impacts Fuel Tax customers consolidating license types, standardizing language, and merging Revised Code of Washington (RCWs) for motor fuel and special fuel. Licensing forms and bonding will be revised. It establishes a new category of licensing – “Terminal Operators”. More information will be communicated on the Internet, US mail and emails as it becomes available.
