

May update

Release 2 Fuel Tax, Refund, Audit, Financial Review and Collections

- Implementation preparation for Release 2.1 of the PRFT Modernization system continues;
 - R2.1 will primarily impact the Fuel Tax unit. R2.1 will allow Fuel Tax customers to register early on May 23, before the first tax filing begins August 2016.
- Release 2.2 – June 27, 2016. Impacts Unlicensed Refund and Fuel Tax accounts. This will be the largest release for R2 and impact the most customers.
- Release 2.3 – August 15, 2016. Will impact our Audit unit. It will provide them with the infra-structure to begin using the system for audit documentation and findings.
- Olympia Motor Carrier Services counter new location is: 405 Black Lake Blvd, Building 2, Olympia WA 98507.
 - There is customer parking for vehicles but no parking available for semi-trucks.
 - This is a co-location with Professional Licensing. We are doing a slight remodel to accommodate the location, provide additional information of services, and more.

Fuel Tax Consolidation Law - reminder

The fuel tax requirements are changing with impacts to license types, language, and the Revised Code of Washington (RCWs) for motor, special, and aircraft fuel.

The Fuel Tax Consolidation Law goes into effect July 1, 2016. It will:

- Consolidate 13 license types into 4;
- Simplify and update the Washington State fuel tax statutes;
- Creates two new registrations, bonding, and reporting requirements for Terminal Operators and Fuel Carriers.
